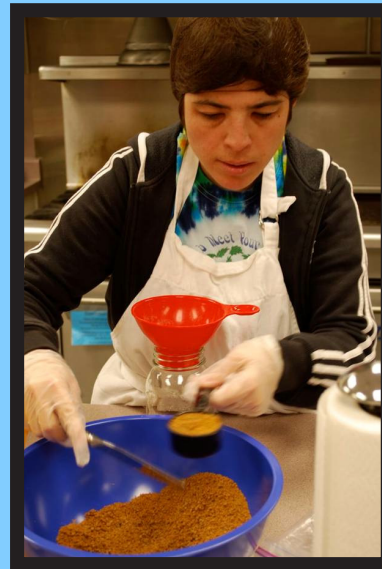
Our mission is to create a work and residential community where adults with special needs can live full, productive and satisfying lives in a God-centered and nurturing environment.
